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

I am in receipt of your letter of 5th ultimo, and in reply have to state that the Officer i/c Supplies at Amiens Street Station has no knowledge of these goods with the exception of 17 bags Yeast which were taken without his authority and handed to Messrs. Rourke & Co, City Bakery, for bread for Military. An Account from this firm is being settled here. The Dundalk Distillery Co's claim should therefore be settled direct by Messrs. Rourke. As we have no knowledge of the remaining items, the Military Authorities can admit no liability.

Your claim has therefore been forwarded to the Civil Authority, i.e., the Under Secretary, Dublin Castle.
