Dear Sir,

on the 1st of August last, in my capacity as trustee, I forwarded a claim for damages caused during the disturbances on the 24th of April 1916 and following days to the above mentioned property, referring to a claim previously made by the tenant of the same property. I have not seen the claim put in by the tenant, Mr. Donald Menzies, but I understand it includes a claim for rent payable out of the premises under his Lease from the 24th of April 1916, which happens to be one of the gale days.

Up to the present I have refrained from taking any active steps with regard to this claim for rent because it seemed to me that to do so might prejudice me in the almost unthinkable event of my being compelled to have recourse to the tenant's covenants in the Lease, and accordingly that the

proper party to put forward the claim was the tenant himself. His claim for this rent, I understand, has not been paid. In the mean time I have been unable to discharge my duties under the Trust Deed by which the rent of the property is settled, to the great embarrassment and inconvenience of the party entitled to the rent.

I cannot attempt to enforce payment from the tenant. Even if a moratorium does not exist with regard to the rent of destroyed premises, it would not be good policy to hamper and perhaps destroy him in his efforts to re-establish himself, and I trust therefore that an immediate payment of the two quarter's rent now due, amounting to £167. 10. 0, may be made to me on account.
