Claim in this case is in respect of a Biggele which was taken under the following circumstances:

mathews is employed as a fitter at the Blanchards town mills on the morning of the outherast his mother to sister-in-law who live in north King Street went to Blanchards town. He went down to his. brother in law who has a eyele shop in King Street. He took the first biegels at hand and wint to see his mother. All went well. tell he reached Rialto Bridge on the return journey. At this place, he was arrested on suspicion by the military, & brought to Richmond-Barracks where he remained for a week. He was then, in company with other prisoners sent to long land and was subsequently released after a fortnight. He has since been out of worth as he cannot get a job the military having taken all his testimorials.

During my intervew I learned that the bicycle claimed for was not his own property but belonged to a man in Duns haughling who had left it in for repairs. He machine in question was a "Fremier" ordinary freewheel 9 evidently had been in use for some time as matthews told me that if it were his own he would value it at about \$\frac{4}{4:10:0}\$.

but the owner moisted on his claiming £9:10:0 for it. He could not. tell me owners name.

This is a case which does not come within the terms of reference. and I have therefore no recommendation to make. In conclusion I might add that I do not think that matthews had any thing to the with the rebellion
