Supplying and fixing 4 G & C Sheets turned out at bottom and two G & C Straight Sheets ^{one} out to template for side of Stand, also supplying two new Downpipes $3\frac{1}{2}$ " diam. x 6'0" long and plugging up 24 holes with Bolts and diamond washers, and painting the foregoing 2 coats of red paint. Delivered and fixed by our men and including the necessary scaffolding required for the lump sum of £9 : 10s. (say Nine Pounds Ten Shillings Stg)
