Regarding de ce un control of the Receiver St is more of the Road of the same Referring to my claim re damages to above during Rebellion week, I have today received a letter dated Brdinst from the Under Secretary's Office, bastle, stating that the compensation autarded me in this matter is 4 %. Considering the damage caused, Iam much surprised at the inadequacy of the amount awarded, and beg to have this claim reconsidered- Lwould hoint out that at the existing hrices of material and labour, I could not possibly hat the property in habitable repair, (at the lowest estimate) than \$\frac{1}{2}\$ 80, and this does not compensate me for the loss of vent or damage byrain to consequent on the serious damage to roof caused in the rebellion I trust under all the circumstances that your Committee will see their way to very materially increase the compensations hayable to me (P. 7.0)
