Sir,

I beg to submit claim for articles looted from my residence above during my enforced absence during the recent disturbances in the City.

I and my wife and family were compelled to leave the house on the night of the 24th April 1916, as the Rebels said they were going to blow up the Railway Bridge close by and that it would not be safe for us to remain. When leaving I locked the doors of the House.

Owing to fighting which took place close to the house and to its subsequent occupation by the Military I was unable to return until the night of the 3rd May 1916, when I found that my furniture &c. had been considerably upset and the articles mentioned in the claim had been looted.
