



We think this matter should be specially brought under the notice of the Committee, as the claim for writing cards etc. is quite a fair one.

Referring to this Company's claim which is now before your Committee in respect of damage resulting from the disturbances in April last, I beg to say that the estimate of £25 for stock of unused stationery in our Dublin Office at the time of the disaster is based on an estimate made by myself to the best of my knowledge and belief, and I consider the sum is fair and reasonable and does not more than represent the value of the stock which was destroyed.

I understand that the claim for £8 for re-writing agents' and policy cards and renewal notices is stated by the Assessor to be consequential loss and
