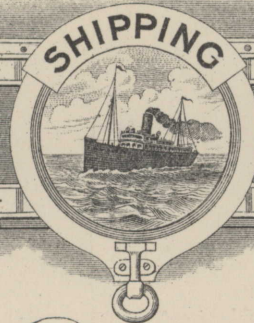

One picture, glass shattered and picture damaged. Glass size 20" x 16".

Wall between Mr Dollar's and Secretary's offices damaged by  
bullets, also walls of Secretary's office. Secretary's window broken.  
Glass size 18" x 32".

General office window damaged. Sash and glass broken, also  
walls damaged. Glass 32" x 18".

Entrance door to offices damaged. Bullet through flap of  
letter box. Inside door damaged by same. Glass of inside door and  
side of entrance shattered. Sizes 48" x 15" Also side of counter  
damaged by Bullets.

Walls damaged in several places.

Outer walls damaged by bullets.
