Glaims 4646 & 4647 - Samuel Richardson. Mr Taylor.

The papers in these cases are enclosed.

Claim 4646 for £25 is described as for plate glass in 52 Lr. Sackville Street - It is now stated that the £25 included also the value of two overcoats and one raincoat destroyed. The loss as described in claim was covered by insurance.

Claim 4647 is for £150 for "the entire glass and "mirrors of all the windows and the shop front fittings of the "premises 46 Henry Street". This was taken as referring only to plate glass for which the Insurance Company were liable. Mr Moran was so informed as regards both claims on the 16th Movember, 1916, and he raised no question till 14th June, 1917, long after the Committee had dissolved.

You will observe that the items detailed in Mr Richardson's Declaration of 18th July and amounting to £129. 7. 6 differ very materially from those mentioned in the claims. Any grievance that the claimant has in this matter is due in the first instance to the very vague and inaccurate

description of the loss sustained as given in the claims, and also to his delay in questioning the Committee's decision.
