Mr Taylor,

In reply to your reference of 8th instant, the Committee's recommendation in the case of Mr P.K. Turner's claim will be found in the 19th List under No. 4669.

The £160 recommended was in respect of wireless apparatus and furniture for School, and as Mr Turner was a debtor to the Marconi Wireless Telegraph Company the name of that Company was joined in his in the recommendation.

A claim made by Mr Turner for £50 return of fees claimed by Students was disallowed by the Committee.

Mr Turner was also interested in the separate claim made by the Marconi Wireless Telegraph Company (No. 4643) on 19th List for a Marconi Installation and he authorised the Company to claim for this Installation.


