Mr Prescott has handed us your letter to him of 23rd ult. intimating that the Committee is unable to make any recommendation in the case.

On inquiry we have ascertained that the basis on which the committee has come to this decision is that the claim must be regarded as consequential. This we suggest is quite erroneous. 
