Interests in the buildings

This building was demolished with the Hotel Metropole. Claimant was 8 years in the employ of the owner and occupier, Michael Tierney, at a salary of 12/- per week plus board and lodging.

In going into the items of claim with her I find that she is unable to produce or give details of where the majority of the articles were purchased, and on questioning her as to the cost price she makes very vague statements from those contained on the form. For instance, the original cost of the two costumes, some four years age, was only £6; and the Furs not £4. 10. 0. but £3. In view of this, and the haziness with which she replies to my questions, I am rather suspicious. I ascertained that the claim was filled in by Mr. Drea, one of the barmen. Personally I believe £18. is ample to compensate this woman for whatever she lost in the fire.
