I called on Claimant and interviewed his wife. I subsequently visited the Solicitors, Smith & Sons, who make the claim and they cannot give any further details, and state that the items cannot be vouched. I am not satisfied that payment should be made, but I believe £10 would be the utmost of the loss.
