As she is not interested in the actual buildings that were destroyed, we are at the same time sending you formal Notices leaving open her right to make a claim, should any of her sub-tenants have failed to do The values of the several holdings have, of course. greatly depreciated by reason of the destruction of the buildings thereon, and it is, therefore, in our client's interest that any sums of money awarded for the re-construction of the several houses should be applied for that purpose alone.
