

Do. Buildings_ BUILDING. Joseph Courtney the owner of No.111 Marlborough Street carries on a fourth rate Restaurant & Lodging House. The Claim is an exaggerated one. Very little damage was done to the premises as a laneway separated No.111 from the adjoining buildings which were burnt to the ground. These buildings acted a shield to No.111 from the machine gun fire coming from the Tivoli Theatre. There were three small windows broken but so far as I could see no damage was done to the shop window frame.

SHOP COUNTERS. some half dozen small bullet holes. Wall Plastering a very few small marks. Range a hole in oven. New door required.

Mantle Piece, was originally white marble but was painted requires a little plaster and a touch of paint. Papering & Painting has not been done for years and no damage was done to justify this item.

Repairing cracks in rooms upstairs. These were in the walls years before the Rebellion. Five Chimney cans I could not see any trace of these on the roof, and doubt if there were ever cans as the other chimney pots consist of four slates wired together. Chimney Stack is old and has been recently patched on one side I could not trace any sign of bullet marks. Eaves, Gutters & Slating Could not trace any damage done here.

I have given a minute description of the damage in the event of any question arising as an Architect appears to have been engaged in making out this Claim. I am, however, of the opinion that £5 will pay for all the damage dowe to the building in question.

Contents Could not obtain any invoices or receipts for the various items of contents as Claimants daughter stated that they paid cash for everything, Doubtless they had a stock in to tide them over Easter but taking into consideration the class of trade done, and in view of the fact that the building items are so grossly exaggerated I consider £12 ought to meet the case.
