Referring to the above claim for £586 with insured amount of £391 for which latter sum Mrs. McNeight has received a Cheque I will be glad if you will kindly place the following facts before your Committee with the view of getting a further sum allowed to her.

I gave the Assessor, Mr. Hume, full particulars and anything further he required I got for him and I believe I am right in saying I was able to satisfy him as to the amount of property burned at the Linen Hall belonging to Mrs. McNeight.

Several of the items, which were not insured, were only stored at the Linen Hall this year and all were put there since the policy was taken out and it is a very serious matter for the claim to have been cut down to such a low figure and Mrs. McNeight is prepared to swear to the value of the different articles and it seems hard for her claim to be cut down to only the insured amount while people who were not insured at all get some compensation.
