INTEREST IN THE BUILDINGS:- Claimant & THE IRISH CIVIL SERVICE BUILDING SOCIETY.

Why these buildings should have suffered is not clear as the occupants appear to leave nothing to be desired. The fact, however, remains that these ^{Interests in the buildings} did suffer from rifle fire as stated, and the estimate for making good the damage is moderate and reasonable.

I understand that the Society mentioned has some interest and that they ^{have also} have also made a claim. I believe the buildings are fully insured and that the Society holds the Policies. Although I have called or written several times I have not been successful in obtaining the Policies from Mr. Hall. The latter has been ill for some time but he appears to have been lacking in completing all his claims in so far as Insurances are concerned, and as regards ^{Signature} the interest in the buildings in this case. Claimant is old and eminently respectable.
