The calling of the claimant (Atkinson) herein is that of a Master Mariner. Some time before the disturbances he forsook his profession for the purpose of running a Fancy Fair at the situation given. A quantity of his property being useful for forming barricades in the district - a troublesome one - was seized by the Military and more was looted. I have made very careful inquiries into this case and have experienced no little difficulty in having the values of such out-of-the-way property checked. As a result of the closest inquiries and investigations, and having interviewed the Solicitor, I am of opinion that my valuation should fully make good the loss.
