

She claims the full amount. even if not used as a Rick Cove, it could be used for some other purpose the loss I am sure would hardly be more the £4 for this article, This is only my openion. as regards the Sledge Homene + the Showel. These articles were commandered by the military and they were not returned to Mrs Boylon and the amount looked for is about what they cost.
