Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 17th instant I beg to state that notification of a claim in this case was received from Messrs. Hopkins and Hopkins in August last, and on 29th of that month forms were sent for completion and return. As these had not been received a reminder was sent on 23rd November stating that if the forms were not returned within a week the case could not be dealt with. Nothing more having been heard in the matter the claim was noted as not proceeded with.

As the Committee has sent in its final report to the Government and has ceased to exist, I regret that nothing can now be done regarding your claim.
