

No. 17 House.

Fan-Sash. Supply and glaze one large pane 32 oz. sheet glass, repair the outside of the frontispiece where struck with bullets.

Side Window in hall

Supply and glaze one pane of 15 oz. glass.

Front Drawingroom.

Supply and glaze one large pane of 32 oz. sheet glass.

Top Front Room.

Supply and glaze one large pane of 32 oz. sheet glass.

The wall in partition in same room to be repairs. also glaze two panes of glass in back bedroom, 32 oz. sheet.

Repair the window shutters and walls where injured in same room.

Kitchen.

Glaze 2 panes of 15 oz. sheet glass.

Repair the window sash where cut through with a bullet.

Front Railing.

Portion where injured to be taken down, reset, and the

front gate rehung.

Roof.

Overhaul the roof, make good all the slating where broken, repoint portions of ridge tiles, clean out the gutters and repair cracks in same.
