CHIEF SECRETARY'S 15065 - 30.AUG.1916 HQ1144. CEFICE The Under Secretary, Dublin Castle. Sir. In continuation of previous memos, I have the honour to forward herewith claim of the following:-Mr J.P. Jacob, Irish National Volunteers, Rathcoole. Claimant has been informed that the Military Authorities cannot accept any responsibility, but I am referring his claim to you as the Civil Authority, and propose to adopt this procedure with respect to future similar claims, in view of the possibility of a Board of Assessment being hereafter assembled under your Office.
