Hack out and reglaze one pane 21oz glass. Sliding door & architrave of window, plugged touched up & painted.

No. 7 Flat.

Partition between pantry & bedroom, plugged touched up and painted. Paper repaired. Wardrobe repaired, touched up & painted two coats & one coat best varnish.

Door & architrave plugged touched up and painted. Bedroom, hack out & reglaze 2 panes 24oz. Shutters of window & architrave, plugged and painted. Walls repaired, and repapered with paper value 1/6 per pc.


