

Dear Sir,

I beg to advise you that I have now ascertained that the dome of our building was injured by bullet holes at the time of the recent The water leakage was noticed by our porter shortly after the rebellion when the rain came, but a few days afterwards on going myself I could not trace the leakages. When rain came again however they became apparent, and I at once instructed our contractors to report to me in the matter. This they did as far as possible from the roof. They could not however properly estimate or do the repairs without scaffolding, so I authorised them to proceed with same and to effect the necessary repairs. I have now received their account which amounts to £5.17. O. as follows: -

To Time and Materials, Inspecting,

Bullet Holes etc. in Copper Dome.


The Contractors, Messrs. Collen Bros. Ltd. of East Wall, Dublin, are those who erected this building and in them the Company has implicit confidence. Their charges are reasonable, and I now put in a formal claim for compensation to the extent of their account as per claim form in duplicate enclosed herewith.
