

After making due allowances and bearing in mind the present cost of replacing Remarks first class apparatus, I am satisfied that my valuation would be just and equitable compensation. The loss occurred when Mr. Wm. Lawrence's buildings were maliciously set on fire in the early stage of the trouble.
