MR TAYLOR.

The Committee have only now received intimation from Wm. J. Craig, 5 Mount Shannon Road, Kilmainham, that he is Receiver (appointed by Deed) over Mr McKee's property, including 88 North Strand Road. The Deed has been produced for inspection.

The paying order for £18 in this case issued by your Department it is understood is lying with Messrs. Bradley & Sons, ll Lr. Ormond Quay, Dublin, pending instructions. If you see no objection this paying order might be cancelled and the Bank of Ireland notified accordingly, and a fresh one for £18 in favour of Wm.J. Craig, sent to Messrs. Bradley on their returning the old one.

Referring to my interview today with Mr Healy of your separtment when I produced for his inspection original deed dated 5th January 1916 made between Wyames Wekee pt part. The Shibernouni Haukhta 2 rapart try seef 3rd part appointing me Receiver over Wylkhees State including the above premises.

When the injury was committed I requested Willehee as the owner to make the claim through Messes Bradley Sons Solicitors and undertook to pay their leasts in the event of the claim not being successful. I subsequently requested the Whee to sign an authority to me to receive the compensation money, but he declined unless I gave him haef what was received, and if not he would drop the claim.

As Mortgages the Bank have suffered in respect of the injury to the premises, and the loss of rent, and not Il. Where the applicant he is not in receipt of the income and at present has very little interest in the premises.

Hesses Bradley Sons I understand have received from the Under Secretary \$18 in respect of memorial elain and I would respectfully ask your bommittee to make the draft issued to messes bradley of Sons


