In reply to your enquiries of the 26th inst with regard to the Electric Meter and services in the above case which we did not value in our report, the Corporation have claimed for all the meters destroyed although they sent debit notes to the various Consumers for the meters and service.

Unless every meter which has been reported upon in individual cases is deleted, there may be some duplicate payments. We cannot tell whether payments have been made to individuals for these meters and it is just possible that up to the present none have been paid for except in cases where the claim was under £1000. In the present case there is no need to include the electric meter and service for payment to the claimant. Latterly we have been excluding them altogether.
