

SHOP FRONT FACING LURGAN ST.

Supply and fix new panel in shutter. Supply and glaze one pane of 26 oz. glass in shop sash. Supply and glaze 3 panes of glass in Counter screen.

PARLOUR.

Supply and glaze No. 2 panes of 21 oz. glass in sash.

BACK DRAWING ROOM.

Supply and glaze No. 1 pane of 21 oz. glass in sash.

FRONT DRAWING ROOM.

Supply and glaze No. 1 pane of 21 oz. glass in sash.

LANDING WINDOW.

Supply and fix No. 2 upright bars in sashes.

glaze No. 4 panes of 21 oz. glass in sashes.

TOP FRONT ROOM.

Supply and hang No. 1-4 panel door as before and paint same to match existing woodwork. Supply and glaze No. 1 pane of 21 oz glass in sash.

ROOF.

Take out and replace No. 4-24 x 12" damaged slates and replace same with new slates.
