re McConnell's Claim.

Dear Sir,

We set out below statement as to the circumstances under which car was commandeered and damaged by the Rebels:-

The car was a Rover of the usual five-seater pattern. It was almost new - about a year old. On the afternoon of Easter Monday, the car was being brought up from Cork to Belfast by the owners son Mr Cecil McConnell. There was no one in the car but himself. Sometime in the evening - about five or six O'Clock, he arrived in Dublin and was motoring along one side of Stephens Green - somewhere near Russell's Hotel. He was stopped by the rebels and told to get out and leave his car behind him which he quickly did. The car lay there, or thereabouts for almost a week.- Meantime the hood had been stripped off it and the other damage done. Eventually some good Samaritan took it to a garage, and when the owner heard where it was he sent for it. The damage claimed for had happened to it in the meantime.
