

NO 8 BURGH QUAY.

Madam,

I propose to carry out the following repairs to above:-

TOP FLOOR.

Repair panel door and supply and fix new handles, receiver etc., to same.

Repair large opening in lath and plaster ceiling.

Supply and glaze No. 11 Panes of sheet glass.

Two pr. Floor.

Repair panel door, supplying and fixing new panel and moulding to same.

Supply and glaze No. 3 panes of sheet glass.

DRAWING ROOM FLOOR.

Repair No. 2 Panel doors, supplying and fixing one new panel in each and repairing lock rail etc.

Refix architraves on inside of door and repair mouldings where damaged.

Repair Vale latch and supply new key to same.

Supply and glaze No. 2 panes of sheet glass.

GROUND FLOOR.

Supply and glaze No. 1 large pane of sheet glass.

NOTE. This pane has already been glazed by us as requested.

All new woodwork etc., to be painted or grained to match existing woodwork.
