forwarding duplicates

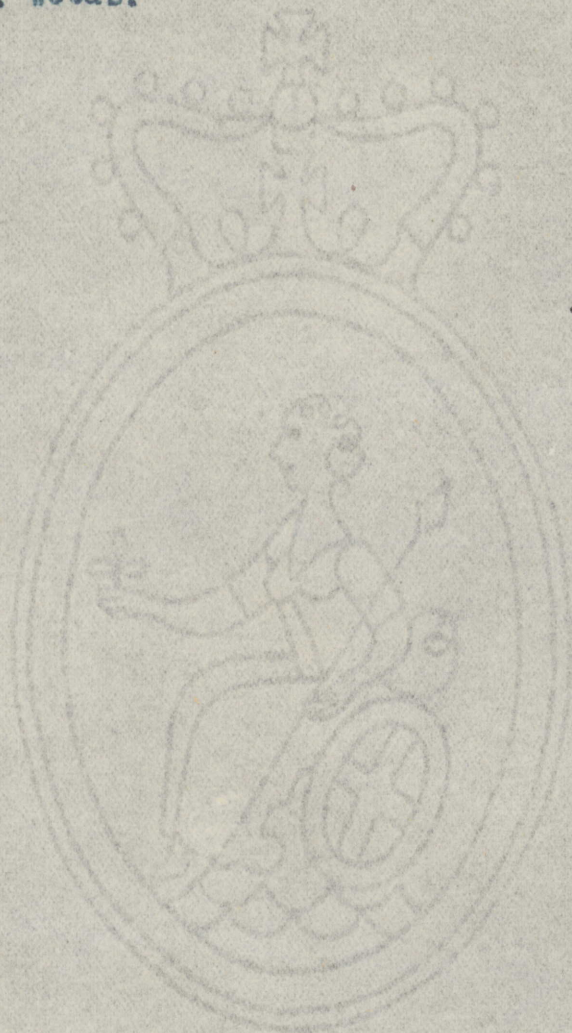
