## Claim for Damages caused during the Disturbances on the 24th April, 1916, and following days.

25 AUG. 1916

do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare that on or about the *26<sup>th</sup>* day of *April*  
1916, damage was done to the undermentioned Property, namely:—\* *an eight-*

and such damage was occasioned to the best of <sup>my</sup>our belief by\*\* *fire at*  
*26 Henry Street*
