The repairs to the roof had been carried out, but judging from the neighbouring roofs these premises must also have suffered. I also inspected Messrs Jones & Son Ltd estimate & receipt (herewith enclosed) and obtained a statement from them. The only work not complete was the servants room. Blackmore gave rough estimate of the damage as £4. but I think £2. would fully cover the loss.

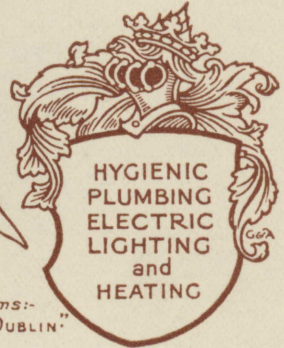

ESTIMATE for necessary slating and building work to be done at the above.

Main roof.

We propose to rebuild the portion of chimney shaft where broken down, including the interior width walls, and properly rebuild same with best brick and mortar. Remove the broken chimney cans from same stack and also two from the rere stack, and replace same with new, about 6 chimney cans in all. The top of the front chimney shaft to be flanchued in cement and sand, and the best of the chimney cans reset where loose.

Slating work.

To remove all the broken slates, and replace same with new double slates, rake out and repoint the ridge tiles where necessary, and make good the pointing of the roof generally where the leakages are shewing on the interior. Clean out all the gutters and remove all the debris from the roof, valleys and hopper heads, and repair all the cracks in the lead work. Also repair the dormer light leading to roof, and reglaze same with four panes of glass.
