Included in above claim which has been referred to Messra. Hume & Co. you will observe that a sum of £65, was claimed for personal effects of three assistants and House keeper. These parties were under the impression until quite recently that it was sufficient for Mr. Murphy to make claim on their behalf and under the circumstances I assume the Committee will now accept their Declarations sent herewith, not withstanding the time for lodgment thereof has expired. Mr. Murphy also in his Declaration which was made on behalf of the Widow and next-of-kin of the Deceased claimed the sum of 175, for personal effects. He has since the making of said Declaration gone into the matter more carefully and instead of claiming 275. he should have claimed 285. 17. 0., 274. 1. 0. there of being in respect of his own personal property, particulars whereof are set forth in his Declaration sent herewith. and the balance fll. 16. 0. as being the value of the Deceased's personal belongings. The claim of 275. in the said Declaration should accordingly be reduced to 211. 16. 0. Mr. Murphy claiming on his own behalf the 274. 1. 0.
