Ellen Kenny, Shopheepe now residing at Ballymann m the cay of Ling find do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare that on or about the day of April 1916 1916, damage was done to the undermentioned Property, namely :- \* One force of Bacon consumed & me by & S Evans of Liverprol Twas looked from he Stores of Men? Tedearte Mi Comecker 60 he such damage was occasioned to the best of belief by\*\*
Sur John Negerious Quay oubling Some lime during he Pebellion week. 15 Pe besty my biling and I beg to refu to a wyry of the moores your foods and to them Indicates bellion to m furning me And we further declare that the Property and Articles specified on the other side were so destroyed or damaged; that the Cost Price of same was as shown in each case; that at the time of the destruction or damage they were respectively of the Values specified under the head "Value of Property at time of Destruction or Damage"; and that, in consequence of such destruction or damage, claim is hereby made for the sums specified under the head "Amount Claimed"; that the Claim is made by me ast the Gume ; and that no person is interested in the said property except ! myselfa and that it is not insured by me or any other person, § except as follows, namely: Company, Policy No. make this solemn Declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of the Statutory Declarations Act, 1835. Made and subscribed the 20 day of 1916, at Buyravalor in the Gurf of Knyf & the said County, before me, a Justice of the Peace for the said VIKnow the Deponent County.
