
re William James Pile's Claim.



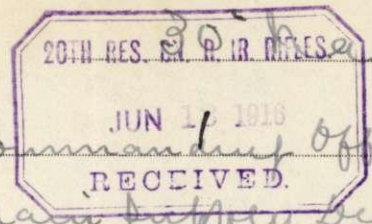


