With further reference to your letter of 18-11-16. re claim by Mr J. S. Young - May St Salway. I beg to inform you as follows:-

On 25th April last, about 11 a.m. during the attack on Clavinbridge Barracks, 2 horses & vans, the property of Mr Young, passed through Clavinbridge En route to Ardahan from Salway, and presumably conveying their usual stock of supplies, viz. porter, ale, whiskey, etc. While passing Clavinbridge the vans were "held up". and the contents seized by the rebels. I regret that no valuation can be placed on the missing articles, as the police did not see what was in the vans. and were not present at the seizure.

51 ST. STEPHEN'S GREEN, EAST, DUBLIN.

Claim for Damages caused during the Disturbances on the 24th April, 1916, and following days.

I We Joseph S Young now residing at Mary Street, Salway in the City of Galway

do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare that on or about the 25 day of April 1916, damage was done to the undermentioned Property, namely: - * 34 dozen Bass ale 16 dozen of Porter, 6 doz. extra Stout, 28 dozen Mineral water, 4 doz. Powers Whiskey 2 1/2 doz. Besses Whiskey, 1 1/2 doz. Port Wine, one lb of Snuff, 14 x 6 doz. Mineral water Cases 84 dozen bottles and 3 wine Cases were destroyed smashed and broken and such damage was occasioned to the best of my belief by** being taken possession of at Heepark Blasenbridge Co. Salway by persons engaged in the Rebellion

And I further declare that the Property and Articles specified on the other side were so destroyed or damaged; that the Cost Price of same was as shown in each case; that at the time of the destruction or damage they were respectively of the Values specified under the head "Value of Property at time of Destruction or Damage"; and that, in consequence of such destruction or damage, claim is hereby made for the sums specified under the head "Amount Claimed"; that the Claim is made by me as the owner; and that no person is interested in the said property except myself.
