Remarks. This claimant is very respectable & reliable & the claim is set forth in a straightforward manner. The original sum claimed was £39:2:4, but the first item of claim is shown only as £10 whereas on obtaining an estimate, at my request, from J. Dockrell Sons (Esq) the figure worked out at £17:3:1. I therefore show revised total of claim at £46 7/5 as above. After deducting retailers profit of £3 7/5 under 3rd item I recommend settlement of claim at £43.


