I had an interview with the managers of the above firm this evening regarding the above claims. The churn was seized by the rebels & taken to the G.P.O. and was subsequently destroyed by fire. The remainder of the damage is to the managers own personal property by rifle fire. The first portions of the claims will bear some deduction for depreciation seeing the articles has been in use for over 2 years. and also the second portions will bear a very slight reduction.

The amount therefore that would be reasonable in this case would be. £8:10:0. *WM* *Q RP*

The property is insured in the "Alliance Insurance Co" & the policy is in force.
