Dear Sir,

I have recently learnt, that I am entitled to compensation for the loss of property, incurred during the Rebellion. My motor car was seized by the Rebels at P. Stephens Green on Easter Monday evening, & was held by them until the following Monday. All the contents of the car (Rugs, Coats, Umbrella, Golf sticks, ^{Boots.} Bags & Balls) were stolen, also the side tail lamps. I should be much obliged if you will kindly advise me, what to do in order to obtain some compensation. My car was shot at, & can be seen here at any time. The bullets perforated the Radiator & Petrol tank (since repaired) also several went into the Connet.
