On June 3rd 1916 we wrote P. Wharton Esq., Traffice Man.

harproceeded G. S. & W. Railway, as follows:-

""On April 22nd we consigned 8 Boxes of Lard to Irish Agricultural W sale Society, 16/18 Dunbar Street, Belfast.

Consignees advised us some time ago that they only received 7
Boxes, we wrote your local people and they failed to give us proof of delivery; we then wrote the Great Northern Railway Co. at Belfast, and they wrote us that they only received 7 Boxes
"Which were received here unentered."

We beg to hand you claim as under and shall thank you for an early settlement.

Claim:- 1 Box Lard - 1-qr. @ 10d. per 1b.....£1-3-4. "

He replied to same under date Oct. 17th (his ref.:- C.A.16509) as follows:-

"In reply to your claim of £1-3-4 dated the 3rd June for a box of Lard - part lot of 8 Boxes - sent to Belfast 22/4/16 not delivered:

I have inquired into the matter and beg to say the box referred to was loaded from Kingsbridge to the Great Northern Rly in a wagon which unfortunately got held up at our Northwall Stn. during the Rebellion and from which the goods were removed by the military without acknowledgement. The Company admits no liability for such losses and I have to refer you to:- J.J.Healy, Esq., Secretary, Property Losses Committee, (Ireland 1916) 51 St. Stephen's Green Dublin, if you desire to follow the matter further
