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

The fact remains, however, that in the event of an ordinary fire, the Policies on Runark the Hotel would not cover such property as Claimant was not a resident, and there is no item in the Insurance specification covering property for which the Hotel Co. might be held responsible.

In my opinion this claim should not be admitted, and I am doubtful if Claimant expects it to be.


