Front Wall. This bears slight traces of damage by gunfire  
 but only in a few places especially the bricks  
 on the edge of the windows. Drain pipe is broken  
 on the bottom.

Roof. As far as I can see there is no damage to the roof.  
 the chimney-pot has undoubtedly damaged, but this  
 is the only damage.

Back Wall This is also slightly damaged, but cost of repairs  
 would be slight.

Interior claim for damage to walls, which is supposed to  
 have been caused by the damage to the roof, but  
 from examination I consider this is due to  
 ordinary causes & was not in any way due to  
 the disturbances.

The claim is somewhat overstated & there are items claimed  
 for.
