Handwritten notes: "Dear Sir", "Some little time prior to the rebellion we sent an Electric Fitting to Messrs Kane & Reynolds, 101, Middle Abbey Street, (now John Kane, Rear of 54, Middle Abbey Street) to be refinished. This Fitting, we are informed, was destroyed with his premises in the fires. Mr. Kane will not accept responsibility for it, and we have been contending that he is responsible to us for the Fitting, and presumed that of course he would have made his claim, and could have made it to the Government for its value with any other claims he was putting in. He insists that it is we who should make the claim and refuses to settle with us. We, therefore, on the 3rd inst., wrote to The Dublin Fire & Property Losses Association on the matter, and they inform us that the Property Losses (Ireland) Committee announced that August 12th. would be the last day".

for receiving claims. Under the circumstances, would you kindly let us know whether -


- (1) We should put in the claim, or whether Mr. Kane should put it in and settle with us.
