Sir,

I beg to inform you that consequent upon the recent

disturbances in Dublin I have suffered loss under the following
circumstances:-

My premises Nos 95 and 96 Great Britain Street Dublin and
premises and stores in Britain Lane Dublin, were entered during
the disturbances and a large quantity of my stock looted and
damaged to the extent of £150, so far as I can at present ascertain.

The goods looted were principally Beef, Cured Fish, Sausages,
Pork, Hams, and Bacon, and in addition, a live Pig.

Under these circumstances I shall be much obliged if you will
kindly have my claim put before the Government in any scheme of
compensation which may be arrived at.
