The repairs had been carried out and the bicycle was fit for delivery two days before the Rebellion. It perished in the fire. I interviewed Mr. Keating's assistant at 2 Bachelors Walk (temporary premises). The machine was an old one (see query sheet attached) and was only value for about £3. 15. 0. before repairing. Claimant does not give date of purchase. Mr. Keating's account is £2. 5. 0. due by Mrs. White Spunner, so that the allow- ance of £6 to Claimant is ample to compensate. It is, however, questionable whether Mrs. White Spunner is liable for the cost be the property of the Bicycle not having been delivered. Mr. Keating says she is; I believe she is not. However, the matter being a trivial one the Committee will probably not raise any question, but allo her to discharge Keating's account.
