Remarks

This Bicycle was left at Messrs. J. J. Keating's, 3, Lr. Sackville St. to be repaired and enamelled. The repairs had been carried out and the bicycle was fit for delivery two days before the Rebellion. It perished in the fire. I interviewed Mr. Keating's assistant at 2 Bachelors Walk (temporary premises). The machine was an old one (see query sheet attached) and was only value for about £3. 15. 0. before repairing. Claimant does not give date of purchase. Mr. Keating's account is £2. 5. 0. due by Mrs. White Spinner, so that the allowance of £6 to Claimant is ample to compensate. It is, however, questionable whether Mrs. White Spinner is liable for the cost of repairs, the Bicycle not having been delivered. Mr. Keating says she is; I believe she is not. However, the matter being a trivial one the Committee will probably not raise any question, but allow her to discharge Keating's account. I am sure he has made no claim against the Committee for these repairs.
