I Mary Radmore of The broft, Hampton mow residing Warwick Widow in the Cit do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare that on or about the 25 th day of april 1916, damage was done to the undermentioned Property, namely :--* 2 Clanwilliam Place in the fity of Dublin and such damage was occasioned to the best of my belief by ** fire and eause of cause of acts of rebellion And $\frac{1}{W_{o}}$ further declare that the Property and Articles specified on the other side were so destroyed or damaged; that the Cost Price of same was as shown in each case; that at the time of the destruction or damage they were respectively of the Values specified under the head "Value of Property at time of Destruction or Damage"; and that, in consequence of such destruction or damage, claim is hereby made for the sums specified under the head "Amount Claimed"; that the Claim is made by me ast Owner and Lessee ; and that no person is interested in the said property except to me the Said mary Radmore — Earl Rembroke from whom I hold under lease dated 19 march 1834 and andrew Mathers who holds from me under agreement dated 1 may 1912 for 5 years. and that it is not insured by ^{me} or any other person, § except as follows, namely :-a Policy of Insurance effected by andrew matters in the Union assurance Society Company Policy No......, Amount £ 600 ----And make this solemn Declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of the Statutory Declarations Act, 1835.
