75 and one box No 76. We are advised by Mr Wharton of
the Great Southern and Western Railway of Ireland, manager,
under his reference CF.1/38101; that package No 76 which
contained 10-41b boxes Jolly Boy Toffee, value £1. 5. 6.

was sent to North Wall for deliveryon April 25th 1916.

The Irish Rebellion broke out on this date and when work
was resumed on May 8th it was found contents of the box
had been taken away, presumably by the Military Authorities.

The Irish Railway Company decline to accept any responsibilty for the goods and refer us to you. We shall be glad if you will furnish us with any information you may have regarding the confectionery in question and also say
