On the 10th April we forwarded per the G.W.Rly. to Mr Eddison of Ballsbridge - 1 case Confectionery No 75 and one box No 76. We are advised by Mr Wharton of the Great Southern and Western Railway of Ireland, manager, under his reference CF.1/38101; that package No 76 which contained 10-4lb boxes Jolly Boy Toffee, value £1. 5. 6. was sent to North Wall for delivery on April 25th 1916. The Irish Rebellion broke out on this date and when work was resumed on May 8th it was found contents of the box had been taken away, presumably by the Military Authorities.
